



COGNE VALLEY PEAKS

Cogne valley is surrounded by many peaks. They may be less famous than others but are fascinating for their beauty and their wild aspect. Their unforgettable panoramas offer gratifying climbs, far away from the crowd on Mont Blanc or on the Monte Rosa massif.

Program:

Depending on the ascent, the programme may change. It is arranged between guide and clients, according to the demands and to mountain and weather conditions.

- Punta Nera and Bianca della Grivola (about 3600m)
- Gran Sertz (3.552m)
- Herbetet (3.778m)
- Montandayné (3.838m)
- Punta di Ceresole (3.777m)
- Gli Apostoli (3600m)
- Torre di Lavina (3.308m)
- Tersiva (3.513m)
- Monte Emilius (3.556m)

Equipment:

To be defined with the guide depending on the chosen itinerary

Duration:

1 to 3 days

Overnight stay:

Bivouacs or huts

Number of participants:

1 to 4 depending on the ascent

Meeting point:

Cogne

Technical difficulty:

Depending on the ascent, level from easy to very difficult

Physical difficulty:

Depending on the ascent, from good to very good hiker

Fee:

From € 400 depending on itinerary and number of participants.

Included:

–Mountain guide fee

Not included:

- Possible overnight stays in huts and transfers
- Technical equipment rental
- Anything not mentioned in the section “Included”
